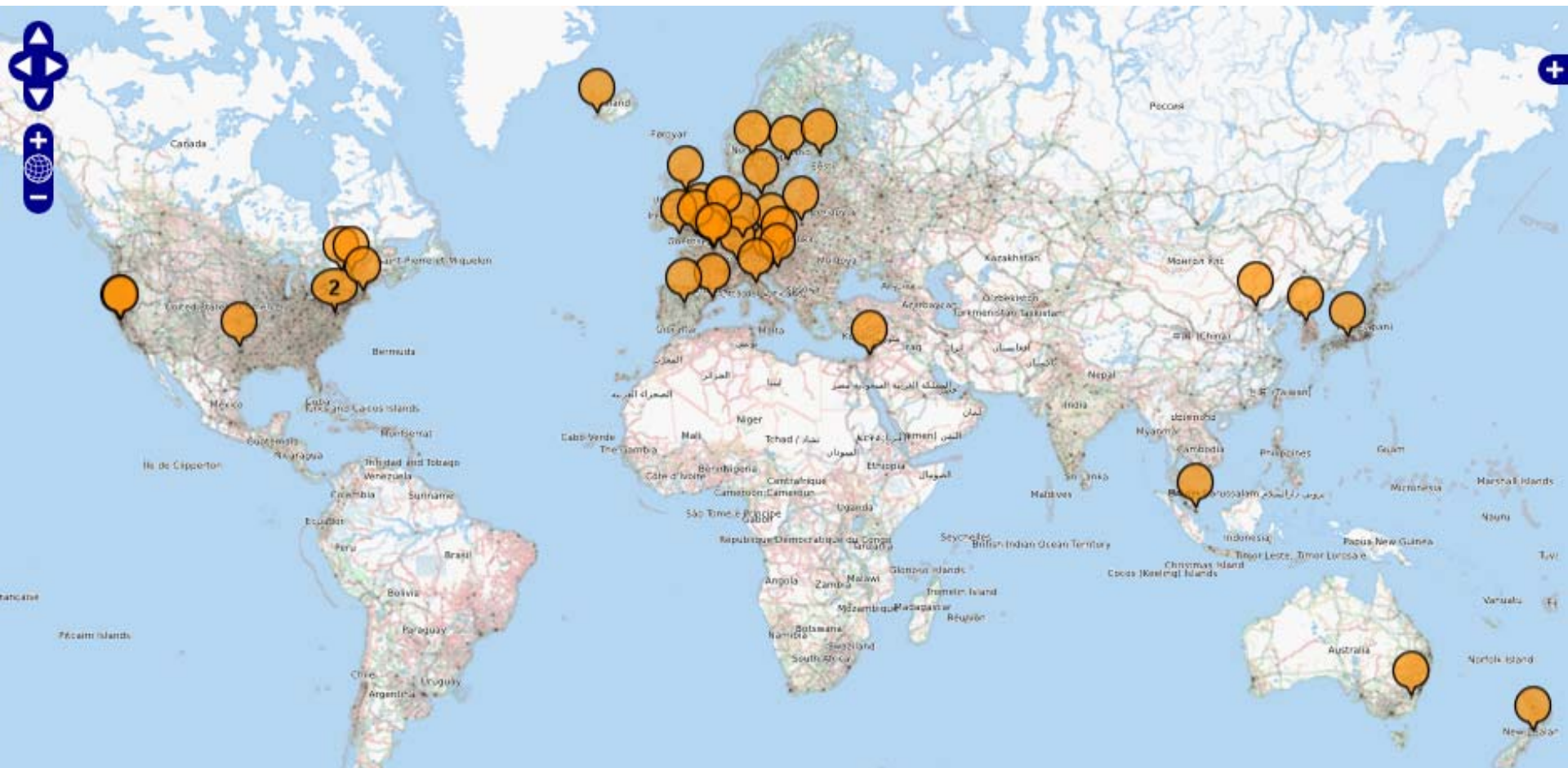

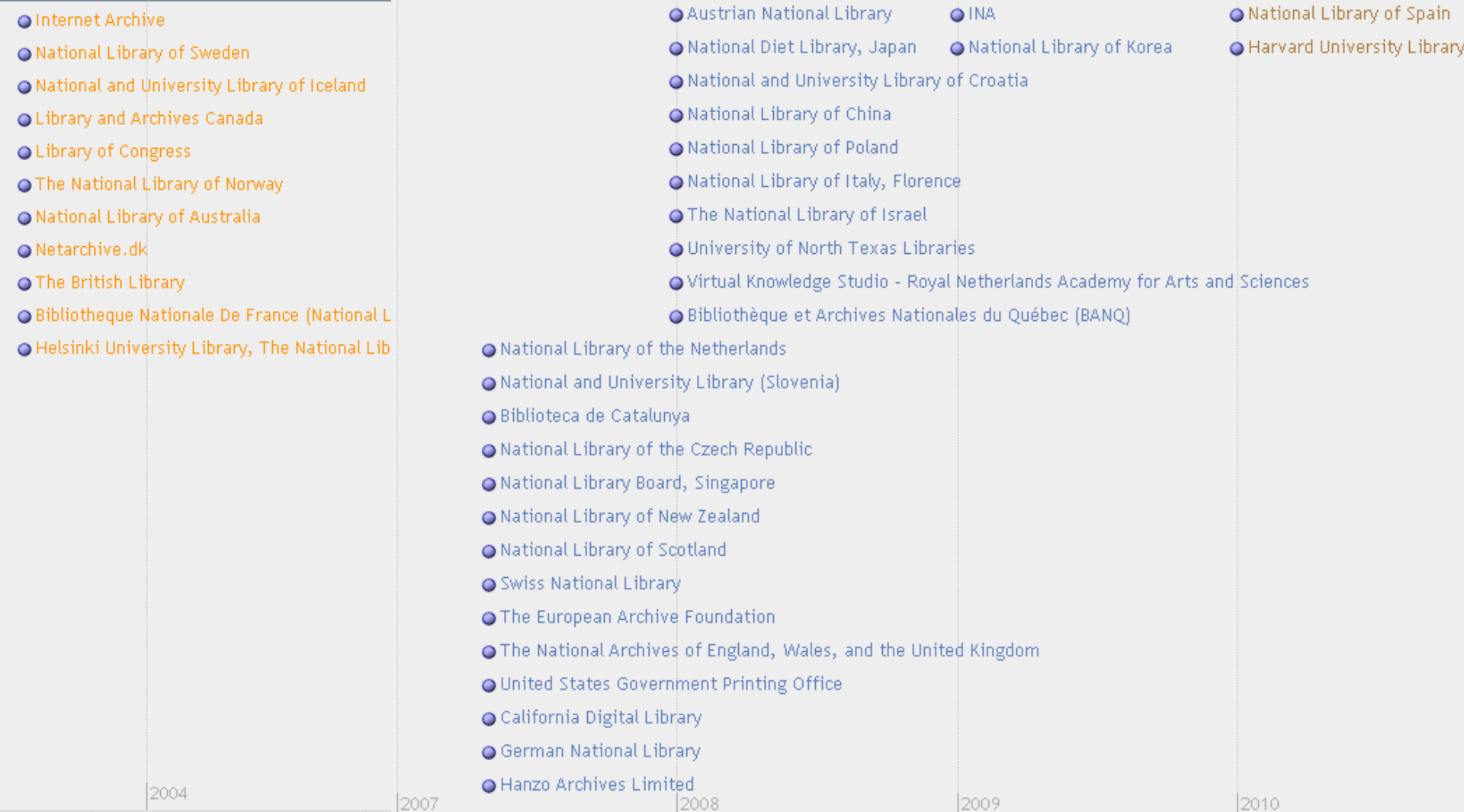

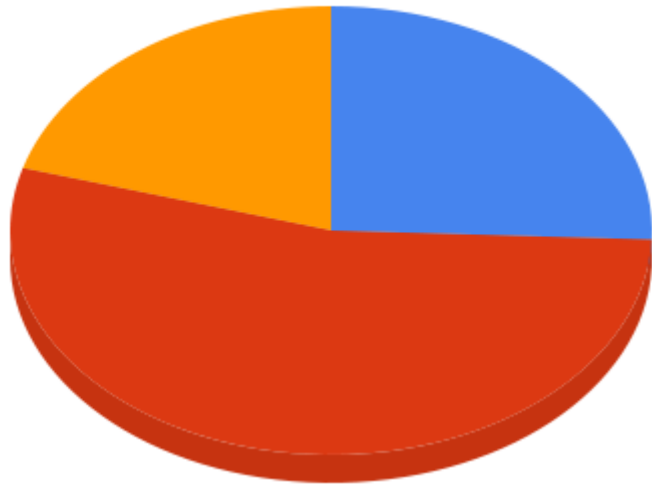

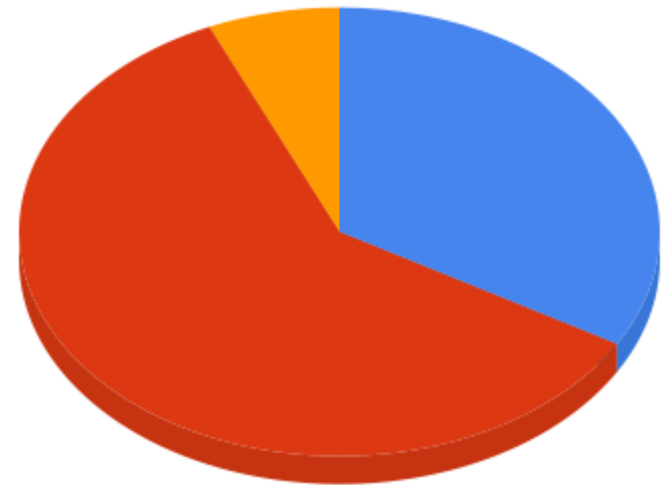
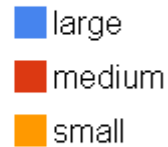

Small: 20.5%

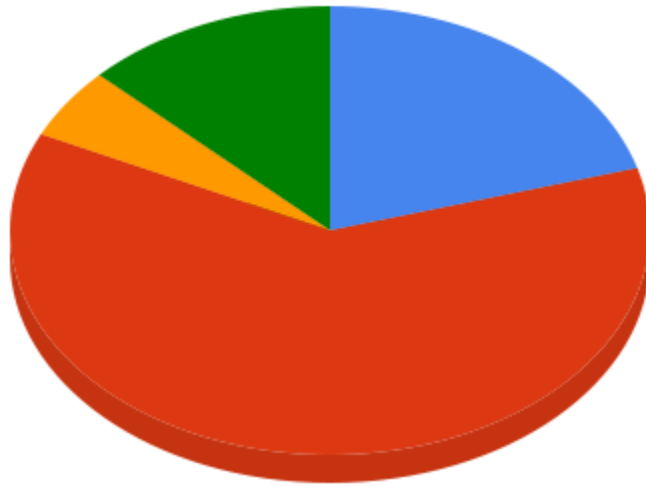
SC by institution size



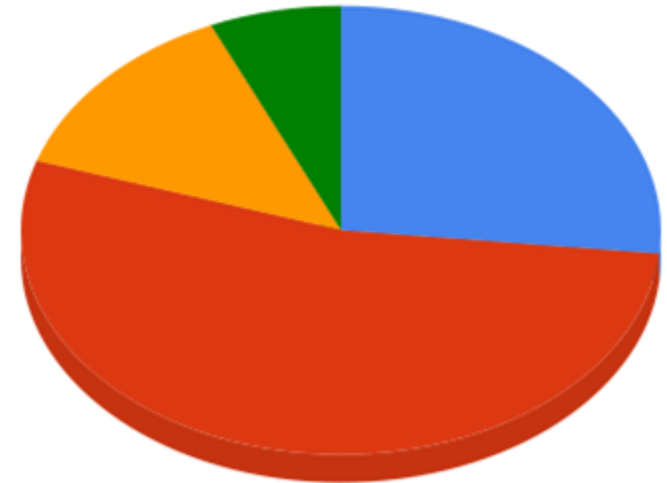
Large: 33.3%

SC by institution region

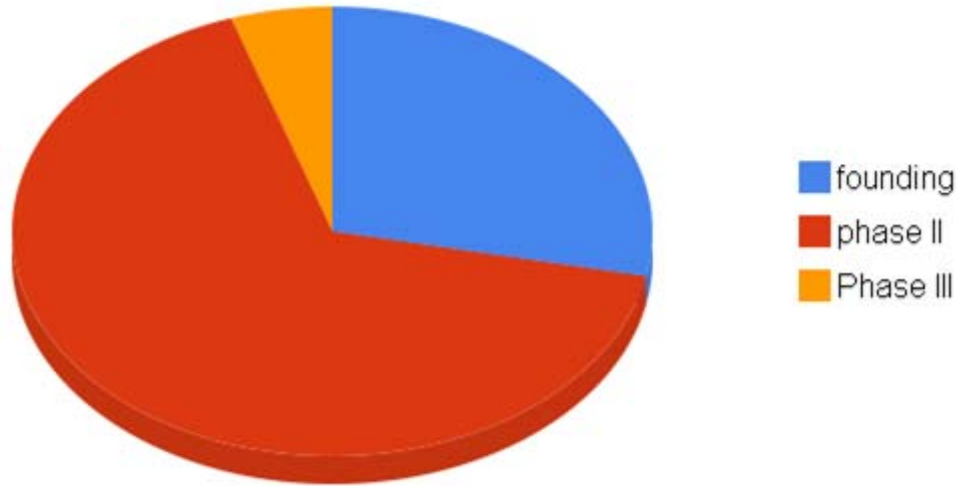


N. America: 20.5%

Asia: 12.8%



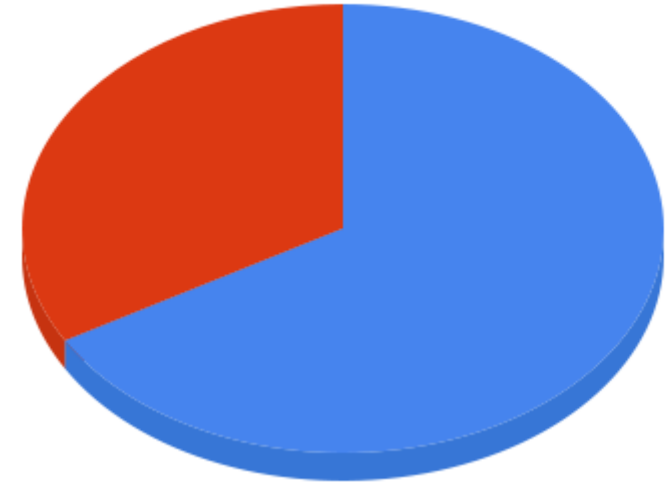
N. America: 26.7%

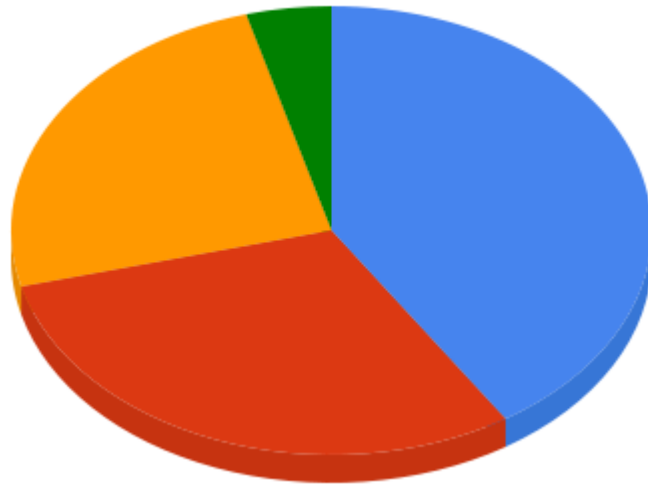
