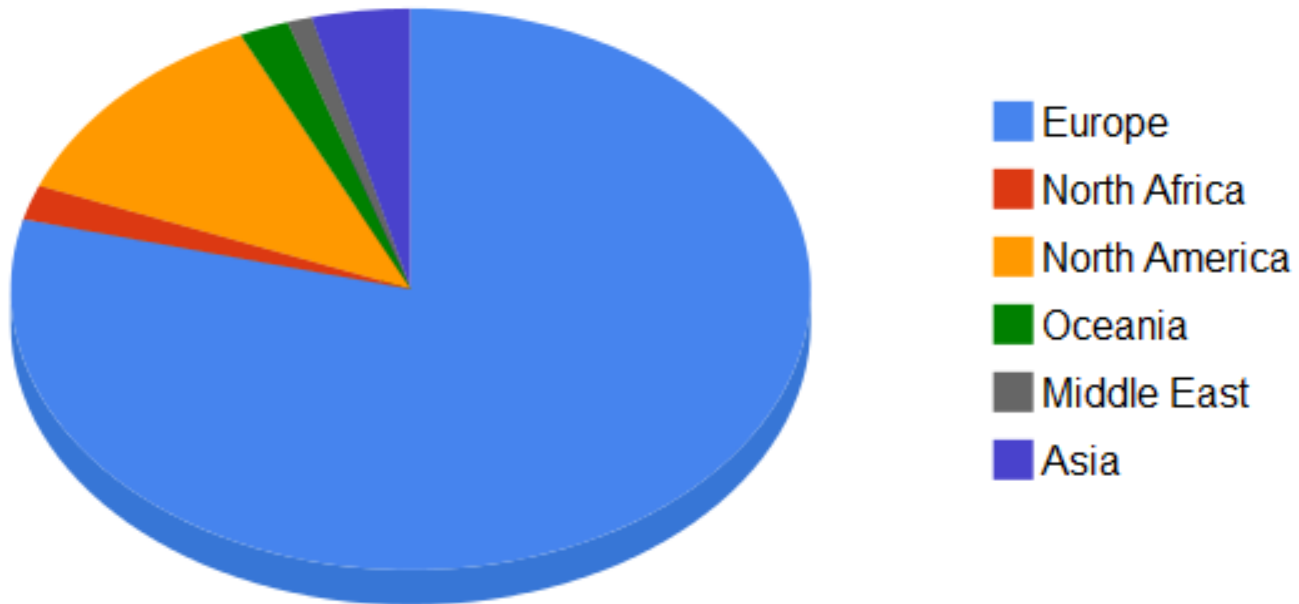

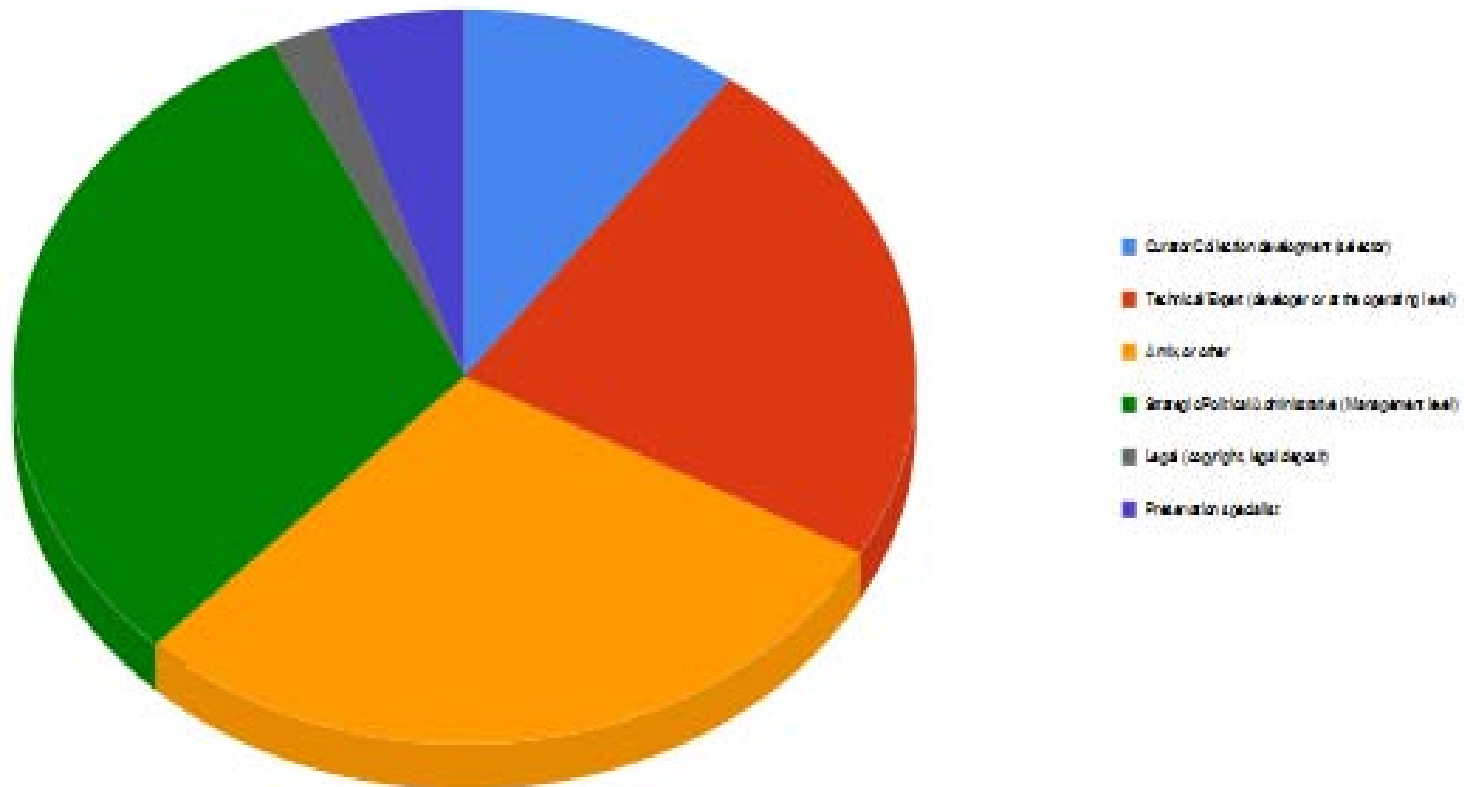

The Web is a rollicking, revealing record of life in the 21st century. But preserving it for future historians is a monumental technical challenge

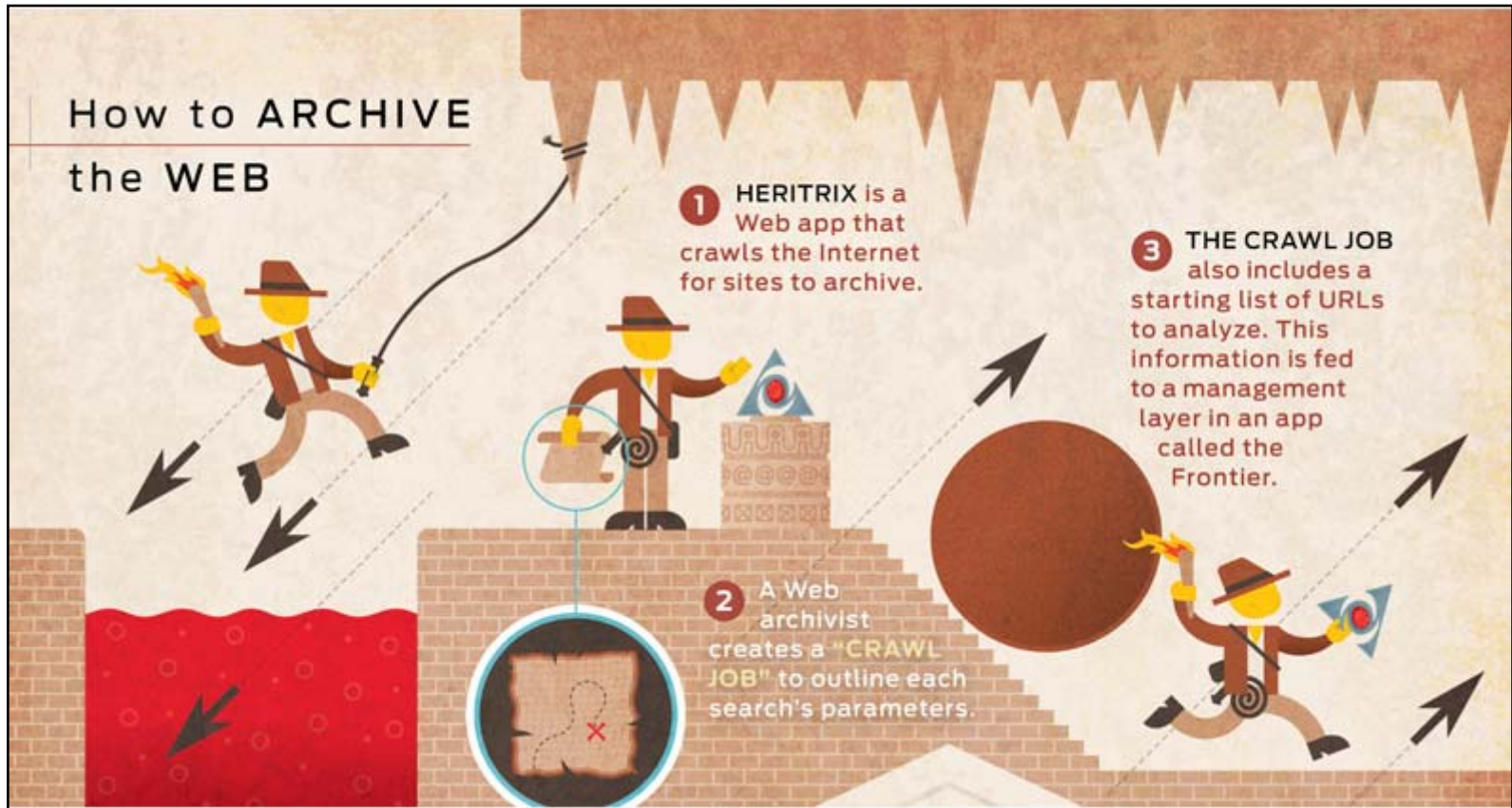

How to ARCHIVE the WEB

1 HERITRIX is a Web app that crawls the Internet for sites to archive.

2 A Web archivist creates a "CRAWL JOB" to outline each search's parameters.

3 THE CRAWL JOB also includes a starting list of URLs to analyze. This information is fed to a management layer in an app called the Frontier.

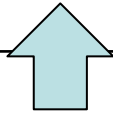
- **Registration has closed** for the 2011 IIPC General Assembly. GA activities include a day-long event open to the public: [Out of the Box: Building and Using Web Archives](#), three additional days of [Plenary and Working Group meetings](#), and a technical workshop on Data Mining and Analysis that is also open to the public. The 2011 GA is hosted by the IIPC and the [The National Library of the Netherlands](#) (KB). All meetings will take place at the KB in The Hague.

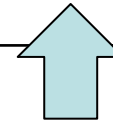
