- Further development of open-source WARC tools, Heritrix, Web Curator Tool and NutchWAX
- Discuss approaches and implement solutions to Web content preservation
- Strategies for collecting and curatorship across the IIPC membership (Olympics 2010 and planning for 2012)
- Internationalization of current and future tools
